

## **JOB OPPORTUNITY: Station Development Programme Manager**

LCR is looking for a Station Development Programme Manager to work on developments at strategic rail locations and around major transport hubs across the UK. This role is based in London, but you will need to be available to work closely with the projects' local partners and development teams. Current projects are located in Leeds, Manchester, Birmingham, London and the South East.

As a Station Development Programme Manager, you will support and co-ordinate the planning and delivery of benefits – focused programmes of integrated transport and regeneration infrastructure investments and activities, in order to maximise the delivery of jobs, home and investment.

The Station Development Programme Manager will contribute regeneration and infrastructure knowledge, particularly regarding the planning, design, funding and delivery of multi-modal transport interchange schemes and integrated transport and land-use development programmes.

### **Key features of the Station Development Programme Manager role include:**

- Supporting local delivery bodies on integrated transport and land-use development aspects of the local vision and local development frameworks
- Advising on connectivity (regional, city-wide and local area connections with transport hubs) to enable greatest benefits from transport links at regional, city and local levels
- Informing commercial development strategies and growth strategies through Development Infrastructure Funding Studies that define delivery phasing and funding requirements
- Co-ordination of the programme of discrete infrastructure project procured and delivered by different stakeholders
- Assisting in the management of the LCR/DfT interface with respect to rail and station development issues
- Providing input into LCR processes, including research, report writing and presentations, as required
